

CHF BC Scholarship Fund Application Form

Application Deadline: Friday, March 23, 2012

Introduction

The Co-operative Housing Federation of BC (CHF BC) works to support the community of housing co-ops in BC. The purpose of the CHF BC Scholarship Fund is to support the educational goals of co-op members, particularly young co-op members who are already making a contribution to their communities. Our goal is to invest in the future of housing co-ops by supporting the education and development of young co-op and community leaders.

Scholarships can be awarded to students graduating from high school and planning to enroll in a college, university, or apprenticeship program; students already enrolled in a college, university or apprenticeship program; and students returning to school after a break in their education.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- ✓ Live in a CHF BC member housing co-op
- ✓ Plan to attend, or already attend, a Canadian, publicly-funded, accredited college, university or government-approved apprenticeship program on a full-time basis in the 2012/2013 academic year
- ✓ Be making a positive contribution to their school, co-op, or community
- ✓ Demonstrate financial need

Scholarship Awards

The maximum award is \$5,000. Scholarship winners will receive \$2,000 in their first year of study and \$1,000 each year thereafter for up to four years of study. Scholarship winners who are already enrolled in a program will receive \$2,000 in their first scholarship year.

The application deadline is March 23, 2012. Scholarships will be awarded on April 30, 2012 and presented to the winners at CHF BC's Semi-Annual General Meeting on Saturday, May 5, 2012. Scholarship winners are required to attend this event.
