Protecting co-op assets

- Since the Planning and Renewal program launched in 2014, CHF BC has helped 75 co-ops create long-term asset management plans (32 this year alone). We've also helped co-ops secure more than \$28.2 million dollars in financing for long-term asset renewal
- Working with our members, we secured Vancouver Council approval of a framework to renew up to 50 co-op leases on City land

- CHF BC secured a \$2 million contribution from the province to continue subsidies to September 2018 for co-ops with federal program agreements ending prior to April 2016
- Our Housing Central partnership gave co-ops and non-profit housing a united voice to "Make Housing Central" during the provincial election campaign
- We broke ground on the new 278-unit Fraserview Housing Co-op as part of a 358-home Community Land Trust development
- CHF BC continues to recognize co-op members of all ages with our Century of Co-operation awards, post-secondary scholarships and YES camp sponsorships
